Satin glass: LuxRaff® and LuxFine® Antiscratch

Congratulations on choosing the high quality of **LuxRaff® and LuxFine® Antiscratch** satin glasses. Their high resistance to scratches and stains makes them the ideal solution for the most demanding applications, such as kitchen countertops, worktables, floors, etc...

To ensure that you enjoy them for a long time in the best conditions, we suggest the following recommendations:

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

LuxRaff® and LuxFine® can be cleaned with a wide range of cleaning products available on the market, except for those that are very aggressive or abrasive (for example, with bleach). The choice of sponge is crucial to avoid damaging the surface: it is recommended to use a microfiber cloth or white stone (Magic Cleaner). In case of using a scouring pad, only those indicated for ceramic hobs are recommended.

For each stain, a solution.

To clean the usual lime residues in the bathroom, use household soap or specific bathroom soap. For more stubborn stains, a specifically anti-lime product can be used. To prevent lime deposits, dry the surface after cleaning.

In the kitchen, the best results are obtained with anti-grease products, and multi-purpose products are also suitable. In the case of lime stains, follow the same instructions as in the bathroom.

Do not let the stains dry out.

The same stain is much better cleaned within a few minutes than if hours pass by. In the case of dry stains, use the same cleaning product, but you will need to rub more vigorously, so it is essential not to use abrasive scouring pads.

The perfect shine with a good rinse.

LuxRaff® and LuxFine® have a special and characteristic shine. Good rinsing is essential so that there are no residues of cleaning products left, which cause the loss of this shine. A final rinse with specific glass cleaning products enhances the shine and avoids cloth marks.

When satin glasses are wet, the surface may show temporary optical effects, which disappear completely when dry.

A couple times per year.

LuxRaff® and LuxFine® remain unchanged over time, do not degrade, and are very easily cleaned. However, it is inevitable that use will slightly dull their shine due to imperceptible residues of dirt on the surface.

Therefore, it is recommended to clean the Antiscratch line a couple of times a year with *Radora Brillant*, a product specially designed to restore the original shine of the glass. (Follow the instructions for *Radora Brillant* to achieve a uniform shine. Its use is not recommended more than 4 times a year).

PREVENTIVE MEASURES

Probably your LuxRaff® or LuxFine® glasses have been tempered. This process makes them very robust but not unbreakable. Avoid overloads and pressures on edges that can cause spontaneous breakages. Also, avoid strong impacts.

Similarly, the high resistance to scratches and stains is not unlimited, so occasional scratches may appear. Most of them will disappear with cleaning, but we recommend some caution in daily use.

Heat-resistant

Tempered glass has good heat resistance, but like any other material, it can be sensitive to sudden thermal shocks. Caution is necessary when moving pots or pans on the kitchen countertop. To avoid risks, it is better to use a trivet.
